



**Invitation for the 46th BSA International Rally
5 - 12 september 2009**

Camping Schoonbron – Valkenburg (Limburg) – the Netherlands

The BSA Owners Club of the Netherlands kindly invites all members and their BSA's to participate in the 46th BSA International Rally. Of course, your partner and children are most welcome too.

The rally will take place in the south of the country on Camping Schoonbron (****), Valkenburgerweg 128, 6305ea Schin op Geul (municipal Valkenburg a/d Geul). Telephone: 00-31 - 43 45 91 209.

Schin op Geul is situated in the south of the province Limburg, 3 km east from Valkenburg, 20 km from Maastricht, 35 km from Aachen or Liege and 100 km east from Brussels.

The campsite is fitted with all conveniences. Plenty of sanitary equipment (free hot showers), a shop where fresh rolls can be bought daily, a snack bar with take away service etc..

In the restaurant (with terrace) it is possible to have breakfast or have a nice 3-course menu of the day (book the day before). There are several fields to play and a (free) swimming pool. Wireless Internet (wifi) is available on payment.

The campsite offers enough space for tents, caravans and mobile homes and has electric hook-ups (4 Amp.) all over the field and several water taps. For more convenience you can hire a caravan at a reasonable price.

More information about the campsite see their website www.schoonbron.nl. (sorry, in Dutch only). Those who want the extreme luxury, they can book themselves a hotel nearby or in Valkenburg via the internet: www.VVV.nl: [search and book - hotels](#) (sorry, also only in Dutch).

Close to the campsite are 2 petrol stations. If you would like to visit Valkenburg, Heerlen or Maastricht by public transport, a bus service stops in front of the campsite, while the railway station is on a 15 minutes walk.

On the rally site in the BSA marquee the "die-hards" can have a drink, tell (lies) about BSA adventures, listen to the music and swing their feet and body.

The dinner & dance too will be held in the marquee.

The Rally Committee is looking forward to welcome you in September 2009 and share our Burgundian lifestyle.

From the website of the Dutch BSA Owners Club (www.bsa-oc.com) the bookingform can be downloaded too. Print the filled-up form and send it, after signing, to your IR commissioner.

1. Caravans

All caravans are provided with a toilet, refrigerator, color tv, central heating, complete organized kitchen with 4-points gas-stove, pans, cutlery and tea set.

The items you have to take are: blankets or sleeping bag, sheets, pillowcase, (tea-) towels.

Sheets and pillowcases can also be rented from the campsite (at the reception) at € 12.- per week p.p..

The 6 bedded caravan's means that 2 out of 6 persons will be sleeping in the living room on the (to fold out) dinette. All caravans have an (outside) tiled pavement with a table and garden chairs.

Categories:

- 1a : for 4 persons simply furnished; available number: 5;
no shower, no hot running water (campsite toilet block on short distance).
- 2: for 4-6 persons simply furnished; available number 8;
with shower, bunk beds.
- 3: for 4-6 persons middle class furnished; available number 10;
with shower or sitz-bath, one 2 persons-sleepingroom and one sleepingroom with 2 separate beds.
- 4: for 4-6 persons luxury furnished; available number 20;
with shower or sitz-bath, (more luxury than category 3, apart from that identical).

2. Hikershut

For 4 persons at the most (2 bunk beds). A sleeping bag you have to take yourself.

They are supplied with electricity and a stove. No household goods, no refrigerator.

(These last items can be rented from the campsite at the reception)

3. Reservation of a caravan / hikers hut

In principle 'first come, first served'.

As there are several categories caravans with different prices, before you send the rally booking form, you must inquire after the requested type of caravan is still available with the rally organization. Telephone 00-31-43 40 93 892 (in evening hours on working days).

From the rally organisation you and your IR commissioner will receive a confirmation of the requested and reserved type of caravan by e-mail.

By return a copy of this message with your booking form must be send to your IR Commissioner.

As soon as your payment is received, your booking is definitive. The reservation of your caravan is cancelled if the payment is not received within 2 weeks of the date of the e-mail message.

On the website of the Dutch BSA Owners Club (www.bsa-oc.com) you can check up which types of caravans are still available.

In case you want to come several days earlier or stay longer, than please contact the campsite yourself.

In that case the same prices will be granted as those of the rallyweek.

4. Meals and breakfast

Daily the restaurant of the campsite can offer you a (buffet) breakfast at € 10.- per person or a hot meal (groups menu with entrée and dessert) at € 16.- per person. Reservation on the previous day please.

If breakfast for the *whole* week is wanted, you can book by the bookingform.

5. Rallyfee

This fee is due by every participant (also for partner, passenger/kids). Children up to 3 years are free (all activities). For children < 12 years a reduced fee applies. The rallyfee implicates the costs of participation on several activities. For the other activities you can book as you please.

No refunds on the rallyfee will be made for whatever reason.

6. Accommodation

The prices mentioned (included cleaning) of the hired caravans will also apply if you book for a part of the week.

For campervans or own caravans the same prices as for campers with a tent will apply. There is no difference between children and adults. Children < 3 years are free. In case you book for a caravan with friends (who pay separate), please mention their names on your bookingform.

7. Booking and payment

Participation to the Rally has to be done by **pre-booking only**.

Payments in **Euros (€) only** and all charges on your expense. Due to bank charges, cheques are not accepted.

4. If you book and pay after 1st May 2009 we can not assure you full participation to all events, nor the rally souvenirs.

8. Confirmation of the subscription

Nif not earlier (for those who rent a caravan), in the second half of May 2009, you will receive a confirmation

(by e-mail) of your participation from your IR commissioner where you pre-booked.

To reduce cost, the rally plaque will not be send by post, but be offered on the rally.

However from the website of the Dutch BSA-OC (www.bsa-oc.com), this can be downloaded (and sealed) if you are keen and want to be seen to join the rally. If you have no internet, ask a friend to make a copy.

BSA Owners Club International Rally Rules

Each participant declares to be aware of these rules;

1. The Rally shall be known as "The BSA Owners Club 46^e International Rally".
2. The Rally shall be open to all members (and their families) of the BSA clubs as recognised by them in their members-lists.
3. All participants will be expected to attend with a BSA motorcycle as defined by the BSA OC (UK) in the BSA OC (UK) Members Handbook.
4. Any person wishing to attend without a BSA motorcycle may do so only if they have permission from the organising committee. Such permission shall only be given when the committee feels that there are extenuating circumstances.

(BSA Owners Club International Rally Rules - continued)

5. Any non-BSA motorcycles that are at the Rally subject to rule 4 must be kept in a designated area whilst on the Rally site and must not participate in any official run out or line up.
6. Any other vehicles, including trailers, brought on to the Rally site must be stored so that they do not interfere with any camping or other site activities.
7. All participants will behave in a reasonable manner and will comply with all reasonable requests to moderate behaviour or to comply with any Health and Safety requirement.
8. Any rules or Health and Safety requirements set out by the campsite will be considered rules of the Rally.
9. Attendance is by pre-booking only. Attendance by members arriving without pre-booking will be subject to availability, after all pre-booked members have been considered, will be subject to a surcharge of 10%.
10. The signing of the booking form is considered as acceptance of these rules.
11. The Rally Committee reserve the right to refuse admission and to deal with misbehaviour as they see fit and will enforce these rules according to their interpretation of them.
